Magic






















Circle of Promise

Nearly 320 employees and individuals joined 37 teams in this year's ARCA on the Move competition, designed to help develop healthy habits in an environment promoting well-being. The regular season lasted 14 weeks, after which 16 teams made the playoffs. Teams were eliminated along the way and 8 weeks later the *Burque Bomb Quads* and the *Watermelons* were the winners!

Throughout the competition, participants demonstrated determination, endurance, strength and consistency. Amazingly, this journey led to ARCA staff and individuals walking a cumulative total of 88,044 miles – 202,501,200 footsteps. What a feat!

ARCA is honored to celebrate our one year anniversary managing the New Mexico Brain Injury Resource Center (NMBIRC). During this time, we have served nearly 1,000 individuals with Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) and have the opportunity to support, on average, 17 people every day.

There is tremendous need for custom supports for people with ABI; vocational and transportation supports can be especially challenging. ARCA's Smart Travel program is working to expand its services to support people with ABI, while ARCA Janitorial is completing its Cleaning Industry Management Service (CIMS) certification. CIMS is the first consensus-based management standard that outlines the primary characteristics of a successful, quality cleaning organization. As a certified janitorial training facility, we can offer people with ABI the resources to acquire job readiness skills and become part of our team.
