Christmas "Zygo" Cactus

Easy care and available in assorted colors. Part Shade to Full Sun.





Jade

Prefers warm, dry conditions with at least 4-hours of direct or bright filtered sunlight. South or East facing windows are ideal.

Zebra Plant

Drought tolerant succulent. Loves porous, well-drained soil. Water when soil is dry to the touch. Prefers bright, filtered shade.





Succulent Bowl

A beautiful arrangement of our various succulents. Porous, well-drained soil is ideal. Water when soil is dry to the touch. Prefers bright, filtered shade.

Succulents

Echeveria

Easy care and available in assorted varieties. Plants should be watered when the soil is dry, but over-watering is to be avoided. Part shade to full sun.







Sedum sexangulare

Prefers warm, dry conditions with at least 4-hours of direct or bright filtered sunlight. South or East facing windows are ideal.

Sedum Clavatum

Sedum clavatum require porous, well-draining soil and 4–6 hours of sunlight. Plants should be watered when the soil is dry, but overwatering is to be avoided.



Houseplants

Swedish Ivy

Basket - \$8.25

An easy houseplant to grow, Swedish Ivy thrives in indirect sunlight and produces delicate white flowers.

Light: Indirect sun





Wandering Jew

Basket - \$8.25

An easy houseplant to cultivate, the colorful striped leaves of this plant range from deep green to purple with two silver bands.

Light: Indirect sun

Variegated Spider

Basket - \$8.25

Spider plants thrive in bright indirect sunlight. Soil needs to dry out between watering.

Light: Indirect sun
