## Brain Injury Awareness Month

March is Brain InjuryAwareness Month, a reminder to focus on preventing brain injuries where possible and spreading awareness of people living with brain injuries. Brain injury is a leading cause of death and disability. Most of the brain injuries reported in the United States are children under the age of 5, young people ages 15-24, and adults over 75.

An estimated 5.3 million Americans live with long-term disabilities as a result of a brain injury. Brain injuries account for at least a million emergency department visits per year. Acquired brain injuries are those that are not hereditary, congenital, degenerative, or induced by birth trauma. They can be either traumatic or non-traumatic. Traumatic brain injuries, or TBIs, involve trauma to the brain from an external force, such as during a fall, ejection from a moving vehicle, or blunt force trauma to the head. Non-traumatic brain injuries are caused by stroke, seizure, oxygen deprivation, tumor, or substance use. Regardless of the cause, the impact of complete or partial paralysis on an individual's life can be significant, affecting their independence, mobility, and overall quality of life.

Brain injuries, including concussions, are extremely serious and require immediate evaluation by a provider who has experience assessing head injuries, and can perform a

neurological exam to judge motor and sensory skills. They can also test hearing and speech, coordination and balance, mental status, and changes in mood or behavior.

The risk of head injuries can be reduced by taking some precautions, such as wearing seat belts while driving, not driving under the influence, using safety gates at the top and bottom of stairs in homes with young children, wearing a helmet while riding and wearing appropriate headgear for contact sports, and installing handrails in the bathrooms and on stairways which reduces the risk of falls in older adults. Additional brain injury preventive measures include consulting a pharmacist to review medications, prescribed and over-thecounter, herbal supplements, or vitamins that may cause sedation, dizziness, or loss of balance. Schedule your annual eye examine to check visual acuity and update eyeglasses. Strength and balance exercises can improve balance and reduce the risk of falls.

Brain injuries affect millions of people worldwide, but the risk of a brain injury can be reduced through mindful precautions.
