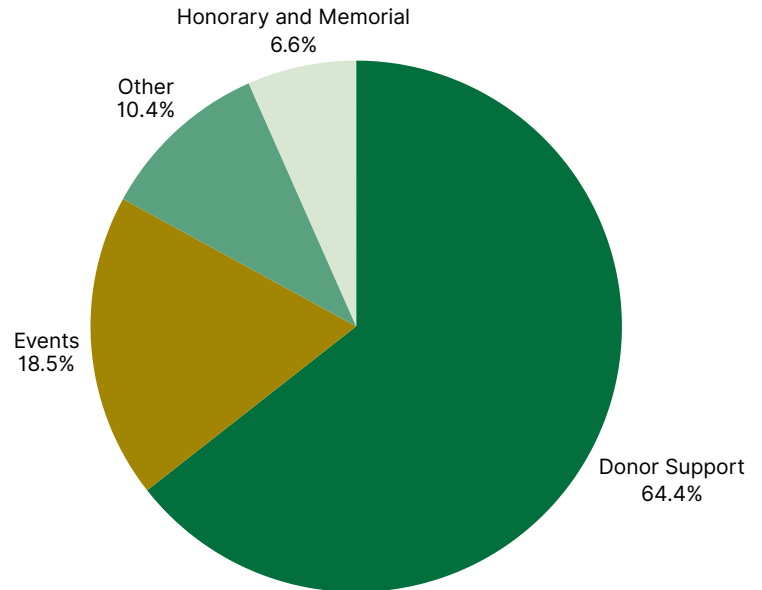

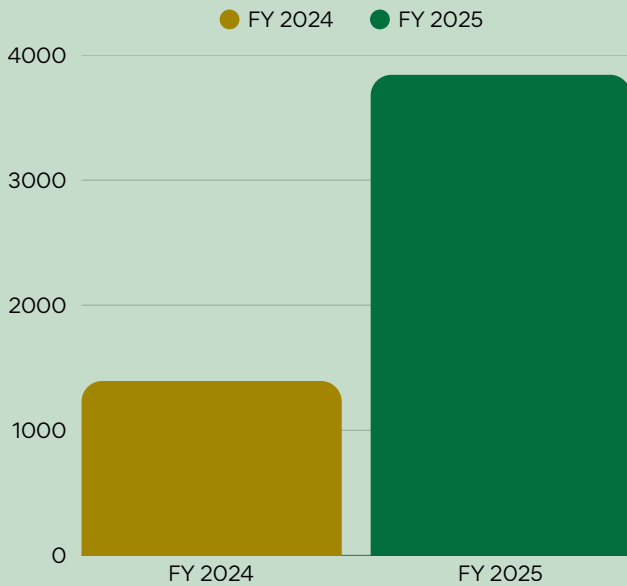

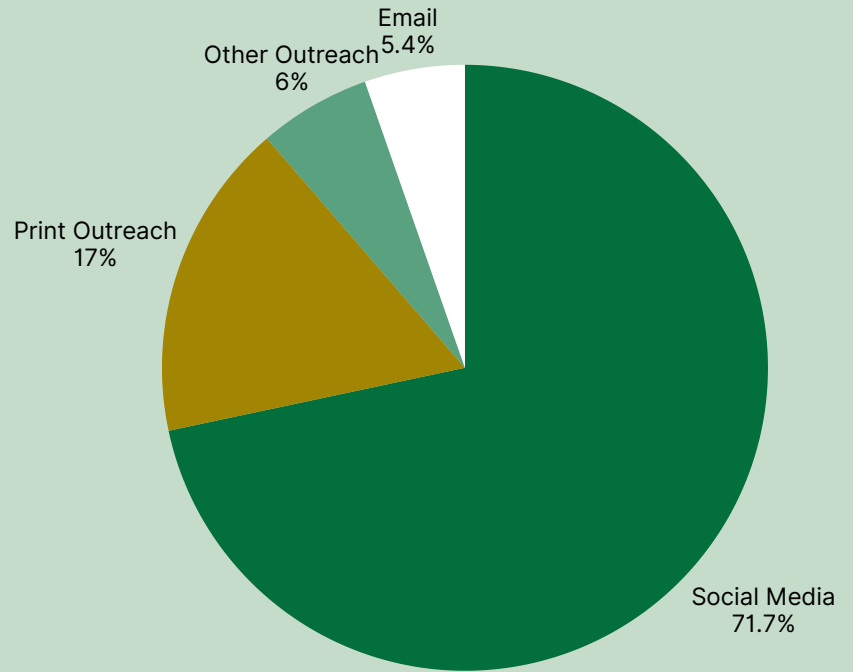

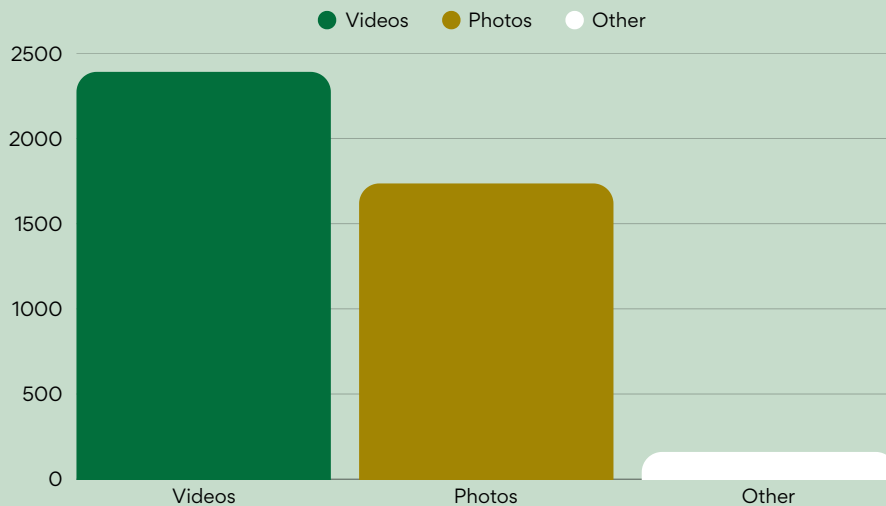
ARCA's Social Media Engagement by Fiscal Year
